TUITION

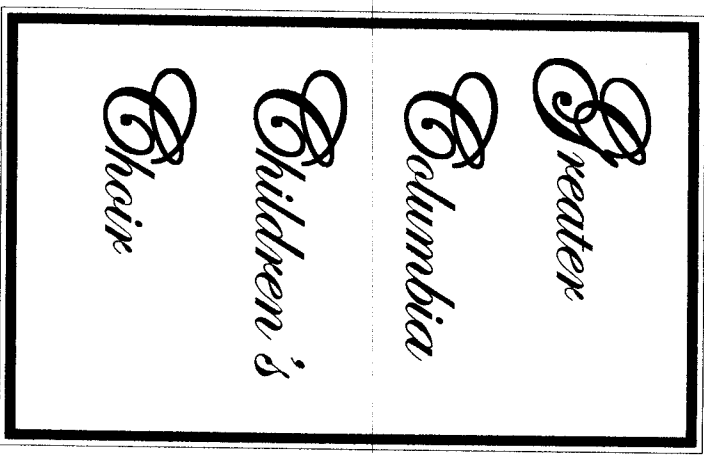
